

Window Opening Control Device (WOCD) Now Available on Select Simonton ProFinish® Brickmould 600 and 300 Products

Meets ASTM F2090 as part of IRC 2006 and IRC 2009 Building Codes

Simonton Windows now offers a **Window Opening Control Device (WOCD)** as an option on Simonton ProFinish® Brickmould 300 Single Hung (including T-mullions), Slider and End Vent Slider windows. The WOCD is also be available on Simonton ProFinish Brickmould 600 Double Hung windows; including T-mullions.

The WOCD has been designed to meet ASTM F2090 as part of the most stringent IRC 2006 and IRC 2009 building codes being enforced in various states and local regions. To meet the code requirements, there are two distinct precautionary actions necessary to operate the window unit past the latches. Homeowners must manually push in both latches and then operate the sash past the depressed latches.

The new WOCD is installed by Simonton during the manufacturing process **ONLY when requested through EPOPS**. A red dot on the latches clearly identifies the releasing mechanism, making the self-activating and self-resetting latches easy to find on the window frame. These latches have passed ASTM load and cycle testing.
